

Ed-Tech Pilot Data Worksheet

Planning an ed-tech pilot? Get ready to gather and review data to improve implementation and determine pilot results. Use this tool as guide for asking questions. Start with one of your own pilot goals and outline your own questions and answers.

Sample Goal 1: Usage

Achieve target weekly student usage, as identified by product provider, for eight consecutive weeks.

Roles & Responsibilities
