CHALLENGE SESSION DESCRIPTIONS & LOCATIONS

DEVELOPING MICRO-CREDENTIALS (Board Room)

Participants will explore the role of the issuer in the ecosystem, identify challenges and opportunities, and discuss ways issuers can support each other, earners, and the system as a whole.

DESIGNING A RESEARCH AGENDA (University Room)
