Protect Your Eyes



Fumes, spinning blades, and other hazards need to be taken seriously.

Wear eye protection.

Secure Clothes, Jewelry & Hair



Loose items can get caught in some tools. Tie back hair, and secure clothes and jewelry.

Protect Your Hearing



If you need to shout to be heard, you may be at risk of damaging your ears. **Wear** hearing protection.

Get Adult Supervision



Some tools require adult supervision any time they are in use.


Seek adult permission and supervision as needed.
