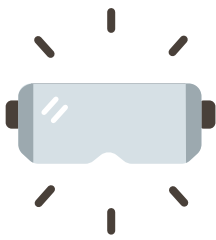


Be Safe in Your Makerspace!

Protect Your Eyes



Fumes, spinning blades, and other hazards need to be taken seriously. **Wear eye protection.**

Protect Your Hearing



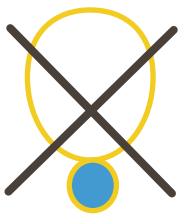
If you need to shout to be heard, you may be at risk of damaging your ears. **Wear hearing protection.**

Designate Work Space



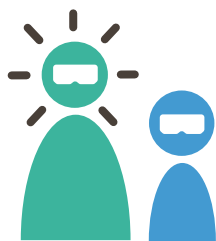
It's good to collaborate, just not with some tools. **Leave adequate space for movement and undisturbed focus.**

Secure Clothes, Jewelry & Hair



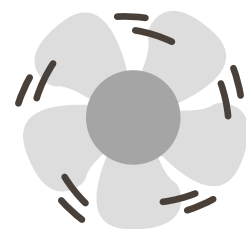
Loose items can get caught in some tools. **Tie back hair, and secure clothes and jewelry.**

Get Adult Supervision



Some tools require adult supervision any time they are in use. **Seek adult permission and supervision as needed.**

Use Proper Ventilation



Tools in the makerspace may produce dust, fumes, or other hazards. **Proper ventilation will help keep your workspace safe.**
