

# A Guide to Using DonorsChoose.org for Participation in the Digital Promise Challenge Institute

Using <u>DonorsChoose.org</u>, you can request funding for professional development experiences including the Digital Promise Challenge Institute. The Institute will be a fully immersive, hands-on, professional learning experience that transcends the traditional divide between speakers and participants to create a vibrant and ongoing community.

### What is DonorsChoose.org?

DonorsChoose.org is a nonprofit website that engages the public in public schools. Teachers from every corner of America create classroom project requests that are fulfilled by generous citizen donors as well as corporations and foundations that want to support our nation's students.

## Can I post projects on DonorsChoose.org?

If you are an educator at a public or public charter school, are employed full-time by a school or district, and work directly with students at least 75% of the time, you are eligible to post projects. For most public school-employed classroom teachers, librarians, nurses, and school counselors, this website is for you!

### Will my project get funded?

Digital Promise has a small amount of funding in place to support educators directly on the DonorsChoose.org platform. We will fund projects in order of submission until June 14 or until funds have been used.

### How do I post a project?

Step 1: Create an account on <u>donorschoose.org/teachers</u>.

Step 2: <u>Download our price quote</u>. You will need this when you create your project.

Step 3: Create your project using the <u>professional development project guidelines</u>. Below is a sample narrative you can use to tell donors about what you will be doing at the Challenge Institute. We also recommend that you personalize this with why you want to attend and how it will impact your students. <u>Make sure you include "Digital Promise Challenge Institute" in the title of your project so it is easily discoverable on the platform.</u>
