# Student Module 2: Global Competence on the Job and in the Community

This is the second in the series of <u>four student modules</u> and will help students explore global connections in work and in the community.

## Module Essential Questions:

- What does global competence look like in the workplace?
- Why do I need global competence for citizenship and my personal life?
- What are the UN Sustainable Development Goals?

#### Assignments:

Each assignment linked below includes a faculty overview page and an assignment sheet. All of the assignments and worksheets can be found in the <u>Student Assignments section</u> of the CTE Toolkit.

## Assignment 1: Create a Public Service Announcement (PSA)

In this module, students are asked to reflect on why global competence is important in work situations. This assignment allows students to focus on the main points of their reflection and present them to a public audience.

#### **Assignment 2: Issues in Your Community**

In the module, students are asked to think about issues in their own community and how these relate to global issues. This assignment asks them to research the issue further and create a presentation for a community group.

#### Assignment 3: Meal Kit Delivery Service Sustainability

In the student module, students watch an animation of Robin, a busy nurse, who scans a QR code on her meal kit to learn how the tilapia came to be in her meal. This assignment asks students to create a T-chart on the pros and cons of meal kit service sustainability.
