

# A Future-Ready Workforce: Student Global Competence Training Modules Faculty Guide to Student Module 3: Preparing for Global Connections in My Career Field

This module is the third in the series of four and will help students understand the international requirements of jobs in their career field.

## **Module Essential Questions:**

- What do global career readiness skills look like in my field?
- How can I analyze my personal career readiness skills and make improvements?

# Assignments:

Each assignment listed below includes a faculty overview page and an assignment sheet. All assignments can be found in the <u>Student Assignments section</u> of the CTE Toolkit.

### Assignment 1: One-Pager on Global Skills in Career Fields

In Student Module 3, students are asked to reflect on why global skills are important to their career field. This assignment allows students to gather their thoughts on the reflection questions asked in the module by creating a one-page visual overview—commonly called a one-pager in education.

### **Assignment 2: Global Career Readiness Self-Assessment**

This assignment asks students to assess their own Global Career Ready Practices.

# **Assignment 3: Global Career Readiness Examples**
