Symposium Themes

- Learner Profile: Education transformation begins with the purpose of education.
 Systems need to be clear on what students should know and be able to do and the
 metrics of success used to measure and certify these outcomes. The framework for this
 theme will be the vision of future education proposed in Kentucky's <u>United We Learn</u>
 report as well as the Fayette County Public Schools' Portrait of a Graduate.
- Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Well-Being: To commit to student outcomes that
 require development of complex competencies, education must be inclusive of all
 students and equally support their learning and well-being outcomes. Learner voice and
 agency is critical to education reform efforts and will be included as part of the
 discussion.
 - In our interconnected world, digital transformation and digital literacy are core to providing an equitable learning environment. This will be examined as a sub-theme leveraging Digital Promise's expertise in this area.
- 3. **Building a Healthy Learning Ecosystem:** None of the topics above can be addressed without a healthy learning ecosystem to support them. This theme will examine partnerships integral to the education ecosystem, beginning with educators, and including families, students, communities, and especially business and industry.
