#### **TLC Goals**






**Ask**: As a group, we will develop 1-2 goals to accomplish over the course of the year. Our goals should:

#### **Shared Agreements**



#### **Negative Experiences** → **Positive Commitments**

- 1. Think of a past negative experience you had serving on a team or committee and identify a specific behavior that prevented the group from being effective.
- 2. For each negative behavior identified, establish a positive commitment statement that your team can adopt that will prevent the negative behavior from recurring.
  - i.e., Being disengaged from a meeting through texting/emailing during the meeting
    → Be fully present and engaged.
- 3. From the list created, identify approximately 5 norms to adopt as a team. Brainstorm what these norms mean and look like in meetings.
