

Tech Talk is a game designed to spark real conversations about how we use technology and social media. The goal is to share our experiences—the good, the bad, and the weird—in an honest and open way.

Getting Ready to Play

Before you start, it's important to set some ground rules. This game works best when everyone feels safe to be honest and a little vulnerable. Consider these ground rules, or create your own:

- **Be Real.** There are no right or wrong answers. Everyone's experience is valid, and you'll probably find that others feel the same way you do.
- > What's Shared Here, Stays Here. Respect each other's privacy. Keep what's said in the group.
- > No Judgment. Listen with an open mind. We're all in this digital world together, and our journeys are all different.
- Go Phone-Free. To truly connect, let's put the tech away for a bit. Turn your phones on airplane mode, or put them in another room. (*If you're playing with task cards, you might need your phone for certain tasks so keep it close by.)





Game Instructions

How to Play

Number of Players: You can play with up to five people. If you have a bigger group, you can pair up and answer the questions together.

Option 1: Feeling Competitive?

For players who love a little friendly competition, there's an option to keep score. Shuffle the cards, and place them in a pile that everyone can reach. The first person to hit **20 points** wins!

- Conversation Cards: Each card is worth 2 points.
- Task Cards: These cards are worth 5 points each.
- Pass It On: If you get a card you're not comfortable answering, you can pass it to the group. Another player can then answer it to earn the points!

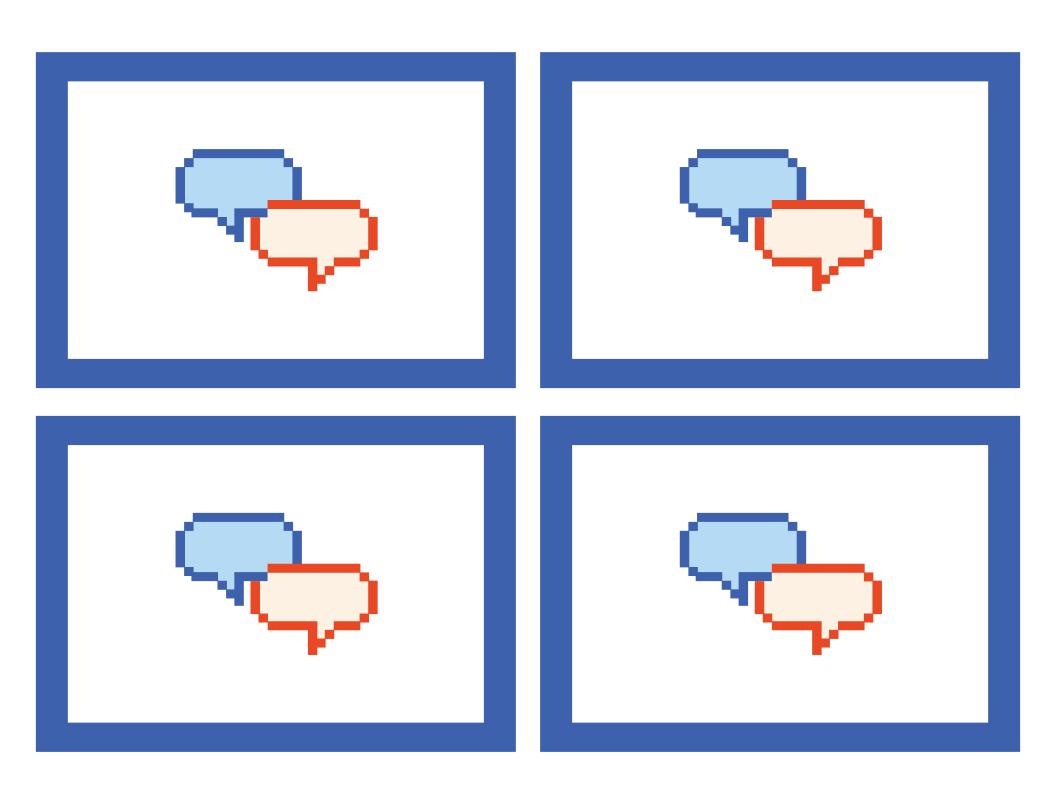
Option 2: Just Chilling

If you're not in the mood for points, just ditch the scoring entirely. Focus on drawing cards and having great conversations. Relax and connect without any pressure.

Option 3: Quick Round

If you're short on time, just go around the circle and have each person answer **2-3 questions** each. It's a quick and easy way to spark a conversation.
